Smart Devices

Many of our children received phones and smart watches for Christmas.

Only children in Year 6 are allowed to bring their phone to school, which they hand in to the office first thing in the morning and collect at the end of the day.

NO SMART WATCHES are allowed in school. If your child comes to school with a smart watch they will be asked to remove it and the class teacher will keep hold of it until a parent comes to collect it at the end of the school day.
